Policies & Practices

We need to meet with city officials in order to examine current practices relating to pesticide use on city property other than spraying for mosquitoes. This information is not readily available, but city officials are also not readily available during the pandemic, so our meeting has been postponed. When we first met with officials, before we were certified, they were very concerned about us trying to curtail spraying for mosquitoes. This was a very touchy issue, and held up the process of city certification. As soon as it is possible, we will work on the IPM plan with the City of Hampton. Dr. Abraham attended the Bee City USA webinar on reducing pesticides on 2/23/21 and was gratified to hear some ideas that can be implemented in Hampton.
