Pollinator Habitat Creation & Enhancement

Continued to maintain and enhance with diverse plant choices. The site is a mixture of herbs, flowers and general food for pollinators (some people call them weeds! like the Goldenrod). Aesthetically there is also a large metal honeybee sculpture to anchor the garden which is on a busy town road/intersection.

Education & Outreach

The Town of Matthews is supportive of pollinator conversation as a whole. A weekly event to illustrate this is the Matthews Farmers Market. This market promotes local, low/no pesticides use and encouragement to plant when you can with an understanding/education on where your food comes from.
